Read Matt. 19:1-9: Pastor Ken in his message stated that when the Pharisees came to Jesus to test Jesus, concerning divorce, they asked the wrong questions. If you could, what questions would you have asked Jesus about a past divorce or would ask concerning your plans for a divorce?

A S K

- Pastor Ken stated when we ask Jesus the wrong questions, it is always a reflection of the problem in our hearts. Reflecting on your life, what has been the condition of your heart when you asked Jesus questions concerning your life?
- Pastor Ken asked an extremely important question. Do you believe that Jesus knows what is best for us? Take a moment and be honest. Do you believe Jesus knows what's best for you? If you do, why? If you do not, why not?
- Read Matt. 19:4-5: Do you faithfully believe what Jesus said in verse five? If you do, have you lived that out in your marriage? If you have not, why not?
- If you have asked Jesus the right question of what you needed to do to be a better husband or wife, how have you seen His answer manifest in your marriage?
- Pastor Ken in his message stated that to “**REpresent**” Jesus, we must be honestly present with Him, we must ask Jesus the Better Questions, be trusting that His Way is the Best way to live, and we must let Him Redeem our past. If these four values are currently not present in your life, what do you need to change to have them manifest in your life?
