

WARM-UP

ASK

- Read Matt. 19:13-15. What do you think it is about children that endears them to Jesus so much? Why does he love them so much?
- The way we represent Jesus is important and we need to be very careful to not hinder ANYONE from coming to Jesus. People watch us in the way we live and the way we interact with each other, the way we worship. How have you represented Jesus in those areas?
- Pastor Larry in his message, asked us an important question. How much time and effort did we spend this week into becoming more like children in your faith?
- In his message, Pastor Larry asked us these foundational questions. First, would we be willing to ask God to fill us with His unconditional love and value, rather than us trying to prove to God, that we have worth? Second, How are you doing on the forgiveness quotient on to scale of one to ten?
