W A R M - U P

Read Matt, 20:20-23: Pastor Larry began his message by opening up the question Jesus asked of the mother of Zebedee's sons. Jesus asked, "What is it you want?" (ver. 21). If Jesus asked you that question what would your answer be?

A S K

1. Pastor Larry asked us to reflect on how the mother came kneeling before Jesus to ask her questions. Pastor Larry then stated the world is divided between types of people those who have bowed and kneeled to Jesus and people who haven't. Reflecting on your relationship with Jesus, where do you fit in that equation?
2. Pastor Larry reminded us that God entered into our world and asked us what is it that we want and that He's listening to our hearts. Yet some of us are afraid to come before God with our anger, our fears, and our frustrations. Reflecting on your faith journey are you one of those who are afraid? If so, are you willing to start now to tell God what you want?
3. In his message, Pastor Larry spoke of the many women in scripture who shaped our faith. He then asks us two questions. As a believer, how do these women's stories shape our faith? What do these stories say to you?
4. **Read Romans 16:1-4,12-13:** How can we encourage women to know that God has a use for them?
5. Pastor Larry in his message stated that the most important thing about our life is to figure out a way to get very close to Jesus. He asked this powerful question. What is the motive of you getting close to Jesus and putting your faith in Jesus? What would your answer be?
