WARM UP

The Old Testament provided specific guidelines for the examination and treatment of those with leprosy (see Lev. 13–14). This leper must have heard of Jesus' widespread healing ministry (Matt. 4:23–25). Would you have had the courage to seek out Jesus? If so, why? If not, why?

READ

Matt 8:1-10

A S K

- ➤ Jesus' family members thought He was crazy to spend so much time serving others (see Mark 3:20-21). But somehow Jesus always made time. We don't always make time for others when they need it. Why is that?
- What can we learn from the centurions in Mt. 8:5-9 and John 4:46-50 concerning our faith in Jesus?
- > Jesus asks him, "shall I come and heal him?" (Mt. 8:7). How is the centurion's answer a reflection of Psalm 139:1-12?
- What is the relationship between the centurion's faith and Jesus healing his servant?
- Now read Psalm 27. This is a Messianic psalm. That means that it describes the promised King of Israel. How does what we see about Jesus in Matthew 8:1-10 connect to the things said about the Messiah in Psalm 27?
