

WARM UP

(ref. Matt. 17:4-5) Peter equates Jesus with Moses and Elijah and is dramatically rebuked by a voice from the cloud of God's glory. Why do you believe the rebuke was necessary? What did the voice from the cloud say about Jesus? What might it indicate?

A S K

- The reconfiguration unfolds in three movements. What are they and what happens? (ref. Matt, 17:1-4, 17:5, and 17:6-9)
- Pastor Larry in his message shared that the biggest lesson he had to learn was his inability or unwillingness to seek out godly mentors who would love him enough to affirm him, but also love him and care about him enough to speak into his life. Reflecting on your life, do you have a similar story?
- > Jesus took Peter, James, and John. However, Jesus did not invite all the disciples, but only these three. Why do you think that happens?
- Pastor Larry also stated in his message that there are people who had all the arguments of why they shouldn't surrender their life to Jesus. Reflecting on your life, have you been one of those with arguments? How did you learn to surrender?
- Pastor Larry asked an important question what lies are you telling yourself to make your behavior okay in God's eyes?
