### A S K

- Read Matthew 10:1-4. Before Jesus gave his disciples a work to do, what had he asked them first to do from Matthew 9:37-38?
- Pastor Larry gave us four truths about our lives as followers of Jesus. Those four are that we are called, we are empowered, we are changed, and we are saved. Think about when you felt you were being called by Jesus. What did it feel like, and did you respond positively at first? Why or why not?
- What did Jesus give his twelve disciples? Do you think this was a permanent gift or just a short term one? Do you feel you have been given gifts from Jesus? If so, what are they?
- What did Jesus do before He chose His 12 disciples? ( Luke 6:12-16)
- Who were these men that Jesus would entrust to represent Him with such authority? We would think they must have been extraordinary men of high standing, integrity, will, and courage. Jesus had spent all night praying about the decision. Certainly, He would pick only the best. Yet, we find that these men were ordinary. Why is that important of us?
