- To quote Pastor Larry, "context to everything matters." Which elements of the apostle's mission was only for them in their specific context? (ref. verses 5-10). In today's context, how are we sent forth?
- What can you learn from the phrase "sent out?" (See 10:5). What were the apostles told to proclaim? (See verse 7) and how is this an integral part of your mission and that of the church?
- What else were they supposed to do (See 10:9-10)? Why do you think Jesus told them to receive no pay for this?
- In the context of verses 10:8-10, What do you think Jesus means when He says, "for the worker is worth his keep"? How does that manifest in your life?
- Because of God's mercy, He never rejects the Jews even though they rejected His Son. (See 10:6-8). You have been sent as well. What is your vision? Who do you want to reach out to? Do you have a target? Do you pray for these people? Do you take initiative to reach out to them?
