What are some things that could cause a person to sin? How have you identified the thing that is causing you sin and gotten rid of it?
- Pastor Jeff stated that we should at the very least be an image bearer of God and reflect what He has given. Looking back in your life how have you tried to be an image bearer of God and reflection what He has given?
- Read 1 Pet. 5:8-9, Jas. 4:7 and Matt 18:7-9: Pastor Jeff shared that even if someone doesn't bring sin to you, it will come because we live in a broken world that is in desperate need of restoration. How should we respond when that happens?
- Pastor Jeff in his message stated that Holiness matters to God and Sin is serious business. Also, that Life outside of God is a figurative and literal hell. How have you tried to rid yourself of the sin that contaminates your relationship with Jesus and others?
- Read Ez. 36:26-27, Gal 5:13-14, 22-23, Psa. 139:23-24: Pastor shared in his message that we can't try hard to work hard, do good, and then fail because Sin isn't a physical thing, it is a problem of the heart. How have you submitted your heart to God?
