- Pastor Larry points out that Grace literally means undeserved favor. In what circumstances in your life, have you seen God's grace bestowed upon you and your family?

- When Jesus was born, the angels announced, "good tidings of great joy" (Luke 2:10). In what way did Jesus bring joy even before His birth? Read (Luke 1:47) and (Luke 1:44).
