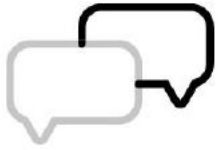

### A S K

- What was different about the third temptation from the other two?
- What human emotions was Satan appealing to in the third temptation?
- Was he offering anything that Jesus wasn't already going to have?
- Do you think Satan could have delivered on his offer or was he lying. Jesus referred to him as both a liar (Jn 8:44) and as prince of this world (Jn 12:31 & 16:11). How did Jesus' response indicate His opinion?
- Why did Jesus respond to serve God *only*. How can we be tempted by thinking we can both serve God and do (fill in the blank). What competes for your full love/devotion/time/resources of God?
- What is the best defense against temptation to put things, or people, or job, or country, or even ministry before God?
- How do you recognize false promises or deception? How can Satan, or your own nature, get to you?
